Two genera of Long-legged Flies (Diptera: Dolichopodidae) new for the fauna of Bulgaria

Abstract. Two species, belonging to two genera are reported for the first time in Bulgaria. **Key words:** *Oncopygius*, *Telmaturgus*.

Introduction

Several new articles were published in the last decade which enriched the number of the Bulgarian Dolichopodide to 150 species (Kechev 2005, 2006, 2007, 2010, 2011a, 2011b) and 32 genera. These publications allowed me to establish two other generic taxa, that appeared new for the Bulgarian fauna.

The material used for this publication was collected from the author in the 1972 from the Vitosha Mt., near Sofia. It was preserved in the collection of the Institute of Biodiversity and Ecosystem Research (IBER), Bulgarian Academy of Sciences. The geographic distribution followed Pollet (2011).

Results

Oncopygius distans (Loew, 1857)

Material studied: Vitosha Mt., Karkama locality $(41^{\circ}18'N/25^{\circ}27'E)$, 18.06.1972, hygrophilous vegetation, 13.

Distribution: Europe: Austria, Bulgaria, France, Hungary, Slovakia, Switzerland. Doubtful for Ex Yugoslavia.

Telmaturgus tumidulus (Raddatz, 1873)

Material studied: At the foot of Vitosha Mt., Bistritsa vill. (41°30′N/23°57′E), 18.06.1972, lown, 1♂.

Distribution: Europe; Asia: East Palaearctic, Near East.

With the new taxa recorded (*Oncopygus distan* and *Telmatogaster tumidulu*) the number of the Bulgarian Dolichopodidae increased to 152 species and 38 genera. As far the distribution of *O. distans* in the Ex Yugoslavia was doubtful (Polet 2011), our specimen confirms the persistence of the species on the Balkan Peninsula.
